




#### Who contributed to spending in Banksia?




#### What were the top 5 spend categories in Banksia?












#### What were the top 5 suburbs visitors came from to spend in Banksia?













## What were the top 5 languages people spoke at home in Banksia in 2021?






#### What was the employment status of Banksia residents in 2021?


