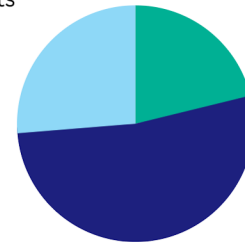

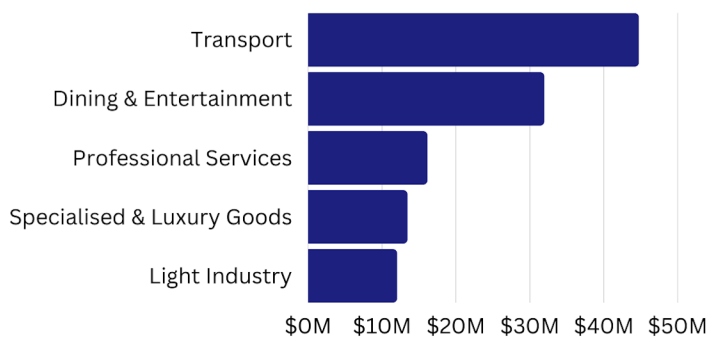

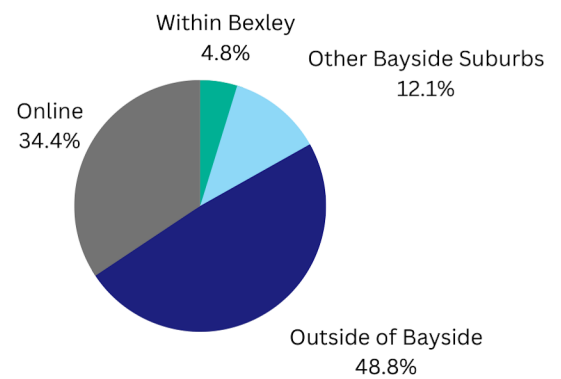

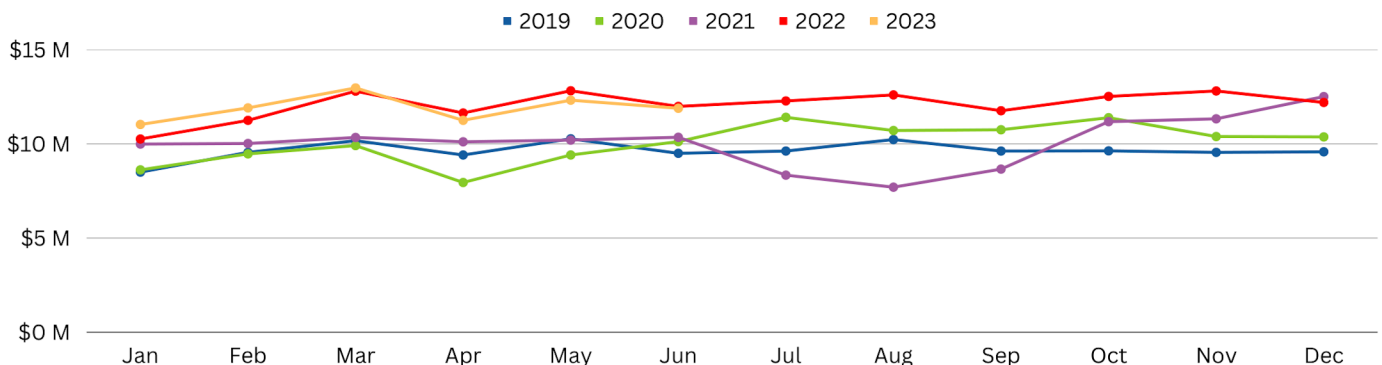
What were the top 5 spend categories in Bexley?



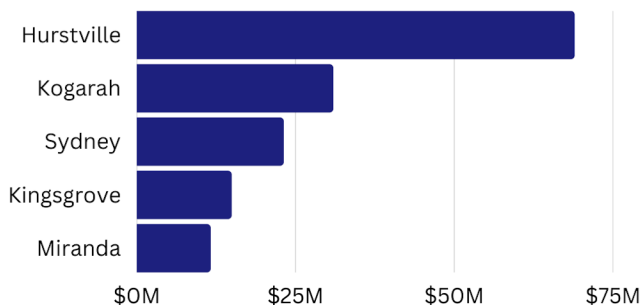
Where did Bexley residents split their wallet spend?



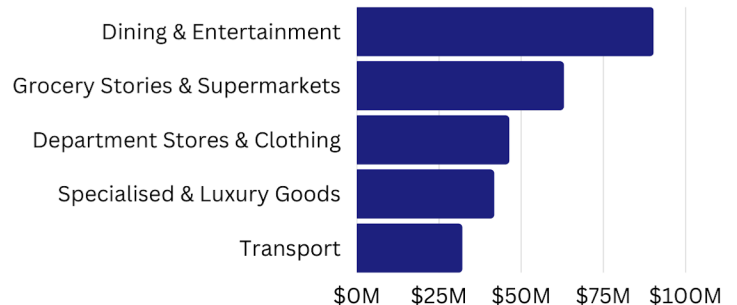
How much was spent in Bexley each month? (compared to last 4 years)

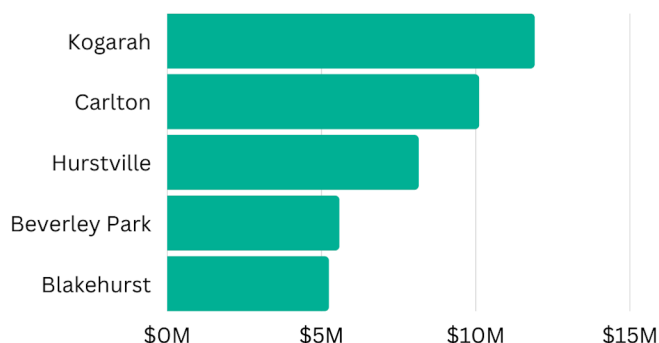

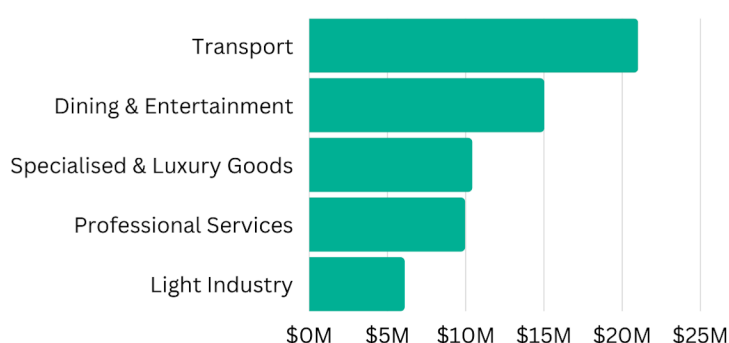

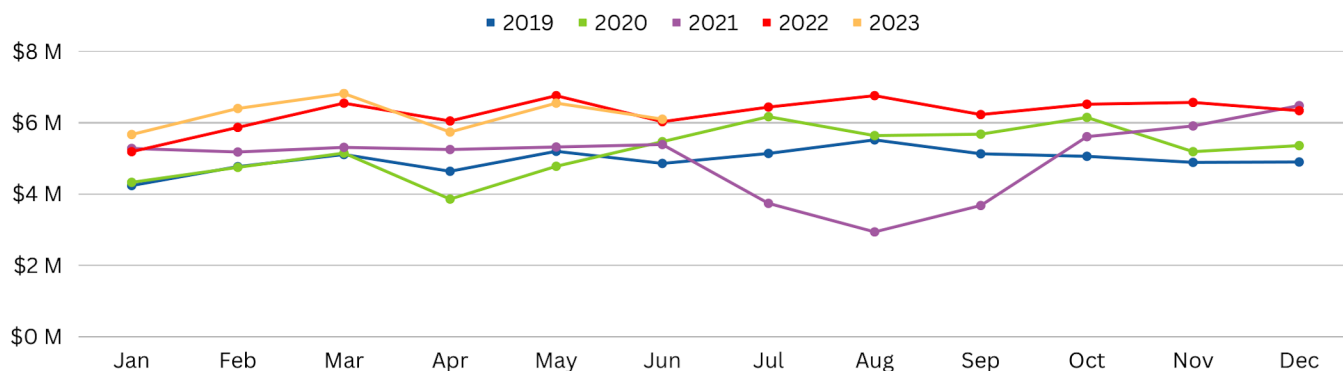
What were the top 5 suburbs visitors came from to spend in Bexley?



What were the top 5 categories visitors spent on when they visited Bexley?

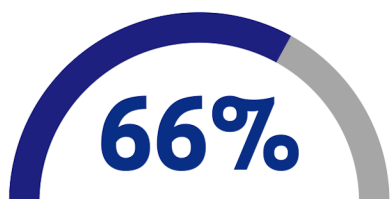


How much did visitors spend in Bexley each month? (compared to last 4 years)

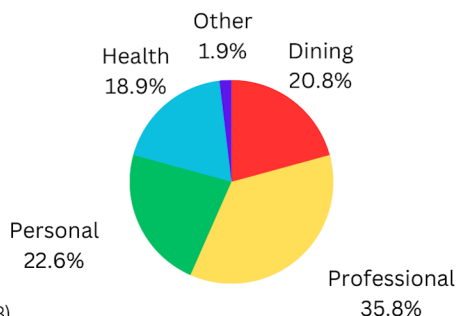

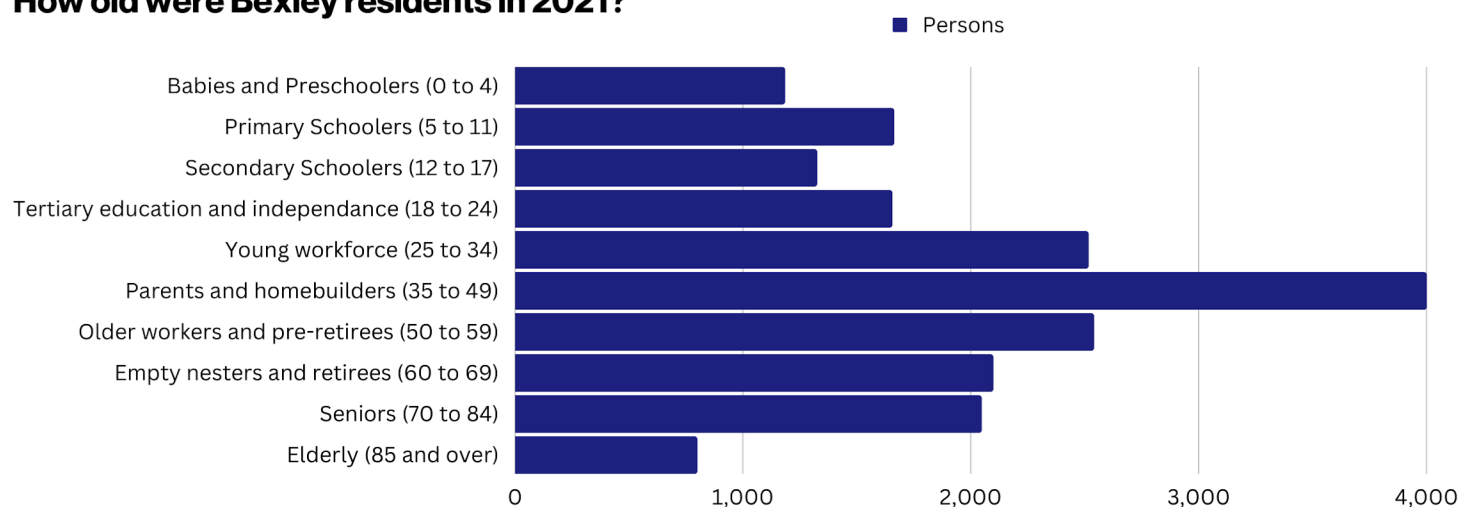

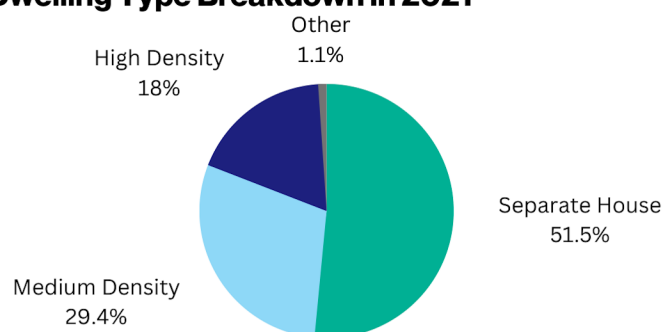

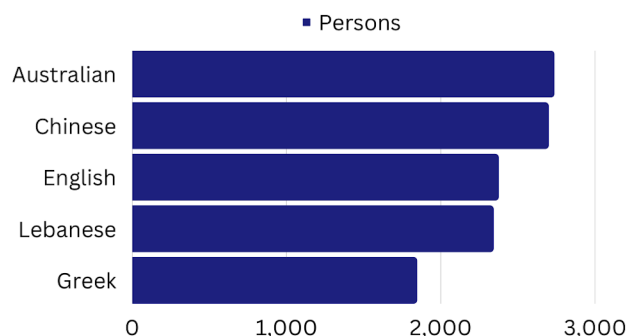

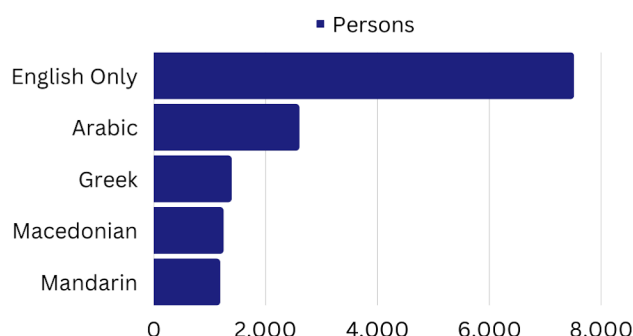
Dwelling Type Breakdown in 2021

What were the top 5 languages people spoke at home in Bexley in 2021?



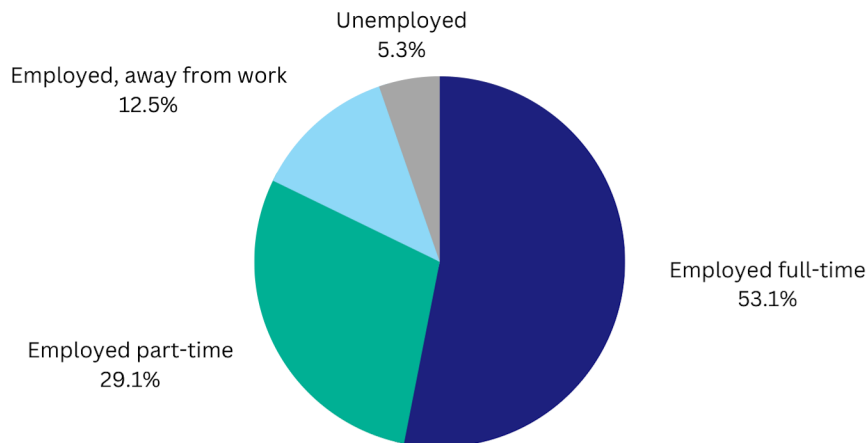

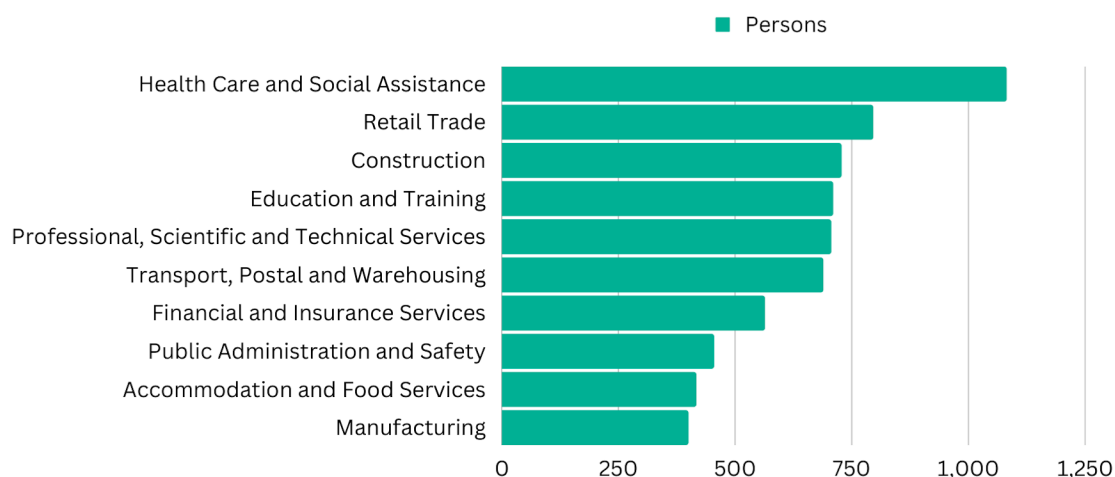
What was the employment status of Bexley residents in 2021?

What were the top 10 industries Bexley residents were employed in, in 2021?

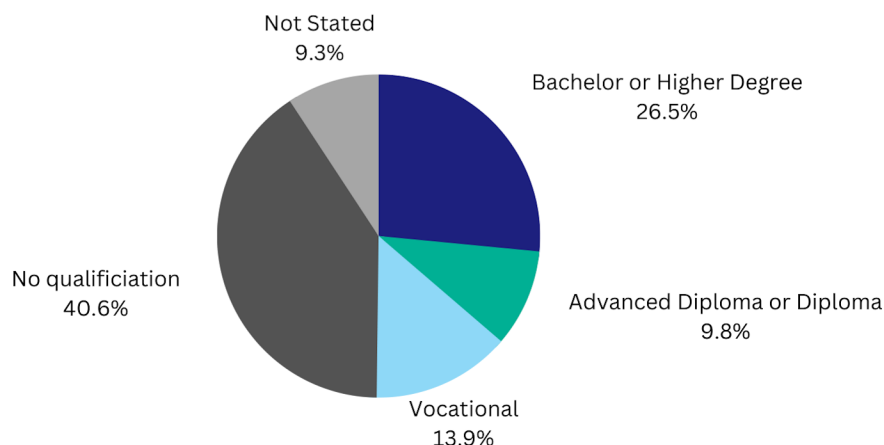
