













How much was spent in Ramsgate each month? (compared to last 4 years)




What were the top 5 suburbs visitors came from to spend in Ramsgate?



What were the top 5 categories visitors spent on when they visited Ramsgate?




How much did visitors spend in Ramsgate each month? (compared to last 4 years)








Dwelling Type Breakdown in 2021




What was the employment status of Ramsgate residents in 2021

What were the top 10 industries Ramsgate residents were employed in, in 2021?


