The Sustainability Award recognises and celebrates the achievements of local businesses that practice and promote environmentally sustainable best practices that contribute to a more liveable and healthier city.

Bayside Council is pleased to sponsor the inaugural Sustainability Award as part of the Bayside Local Business Awards. This award builds upon Council's work to promote sustainable best practice across our business community.

Local businesses nominating for this award must demonstrate the integration of sustainability practices to their business planning, operations and marketing and may include but not be limited to:

### Energy Smart - energy efficiency of gas and electricity e.g.

- · Energy efficient lighting
- · Energy efficient equipment
- Use low energy heating/cooling and ventilation
- · Energy efficient appliances
- · Natural light
- Install insulation
- Transition to electrification
- Open windows
- Renewable energy
- Carbon offsetting
- · Green roof

#### Water Wise - water efficiency and improving waterway health e.g.

- Water efficient appliances
- Reducing potable (drinking) water use, Installing rainwater tank(s) leak detection and rectification
- Stormwater collection
  - Green infrastructure
- Use practices to reduce or combat water pollution
- Water sensitive urban designs

#### Rethink Waste - avoiding, reducing and recycling e.g.

- Reduce waste and packaging
- Implement sustainable waste management / circular economy
- Recycle paper/cardboard
- · Recycle cans, bottles
- Recycle food/organic scraps
- Use recycled materials

### Environmentally friendly materials, products and services- eg.

- · use recycled materials
- using sustainable building systems
- use of locally grown food or locally produced goods
- · reduce/replace environmentally harmful materials

#### Community Partnerships - partnering with the community on environmental issues e.g.

sponsor school or community events

• engage with community on environmental sustainability

#### Sustainable transport - eg.

- · reduction in use of fossil fuel
- Transition to electric vehicles and low emission mobility such as e-bikes, e-scooter.
- Provide bike racks and end of trip facilities
- · promote public transport, use of bicycles and carpooling
- Develop and Implement Green Travel Plan
- · Reduction of food mileage by purchasing locally

## Eligibility - This award is open to businesses and non-profit organisations that:

- Are small businesses (having an annual turnover of less than \$10 million)
- · Operate within the Bayside LGA

#### Judging

· Entries will be assessed on the information submitted and you may be contacted for further information from the judging panel. The panel includes Precedent staff and community members, under advisory of a Bayside Council environment expert. A site visit may be conducted to inform the judging process.
