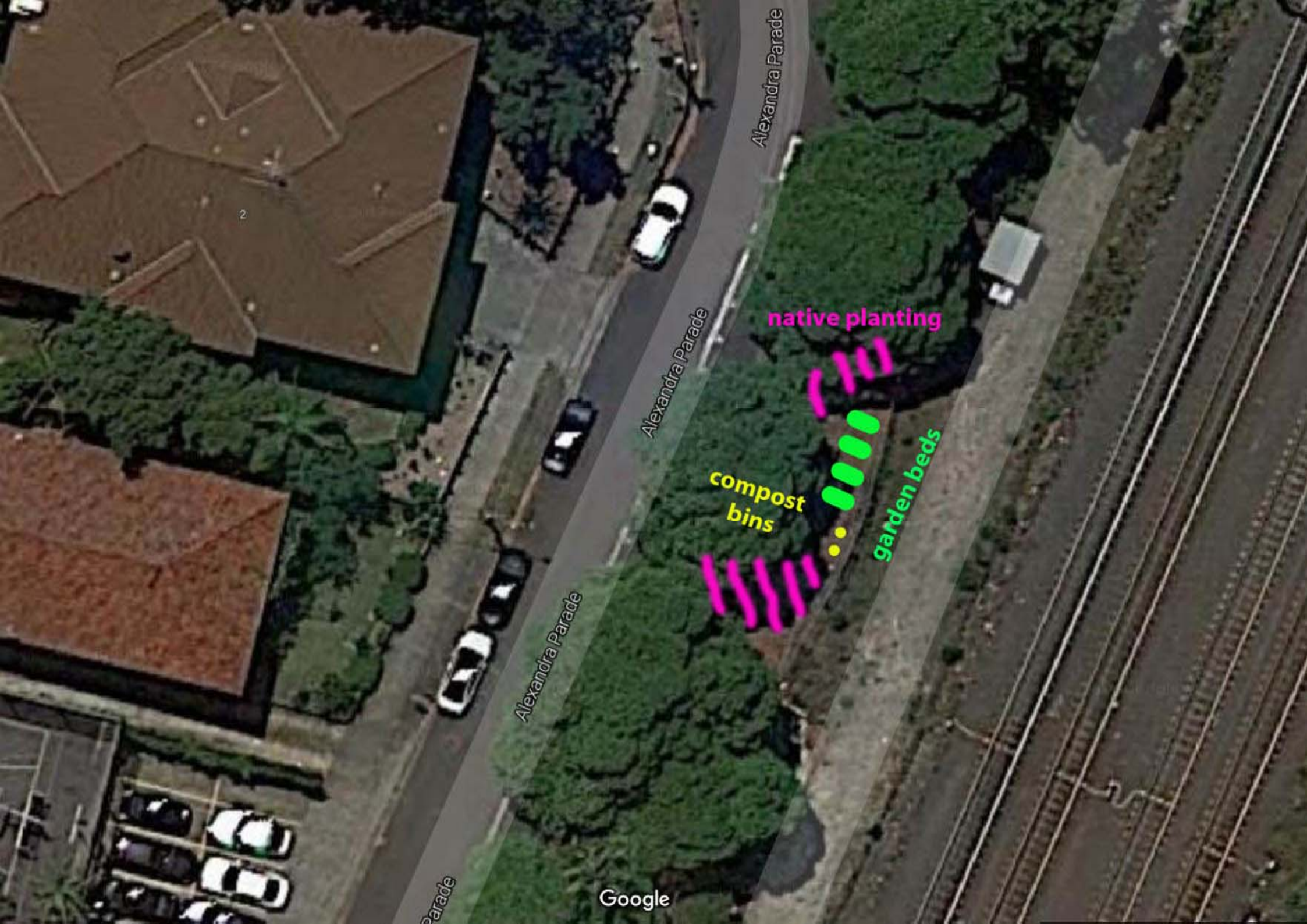

- Council review, three weeks.
- Six week public exhibition period.
- Feedback from local residents and business considered by Council, 2 weeks.
- Following the review period, you will be contacted to either amend your application or if approved, enter into a formal licence agreement with Council. If your community garden group has 12 or more members, the group will need to become incorporated and obtain public liability insurance before a license to start your garden will be given. Note, no works can be commenced at the community garden until a formal license has been granted.
