






What were the top 5 spend categories in Arncliffe?




Where did Arncliffe residents split their wallet spend? Within Arncliffe




How much was spent in Arncliffe each month? (compared to last 4 years)






What were the top 5 suburbs visitors came from to spend in Arncliffe?















Dwelling Type Breakdown in 2021




What was the employment status of Arncliffe residents?

What was the top 10 industries Arncliffe residents were employed in, in 2021?


