




Who contributed to spending in Ramsgate Beach?






Where did Ramsgate Beach residents split their wallet spend?




How much was spent in Ramsgate Beach each month? (compared to last 4 years)






What were the top 5 suburbs visitors came from to spend in Ramsgate Beach?












What is the employment status of Ramsgate Beach residents?




Change in employed people from 2016 to 2021
