




Who contributed to spending in Mascot?




What were the top 5 spend categories in Mascot?




Where did Mascot residents split their wallet spend?




How much was spent in Mascot each month? (compared to last 4 years)






What were the top 5 suburbs visitors came from to spend in Mascot?

How much did visitors spend in Mascot each month? (compared to last 4 years)
















Dwelling Type Breakdown in 2021

What were the top 5 languages people spoke at home in Mascot in 2021?






What was the employment status of Mascot residents in 2021?

What were the top 10 industries Mascot residents were employed in, in 2021?


