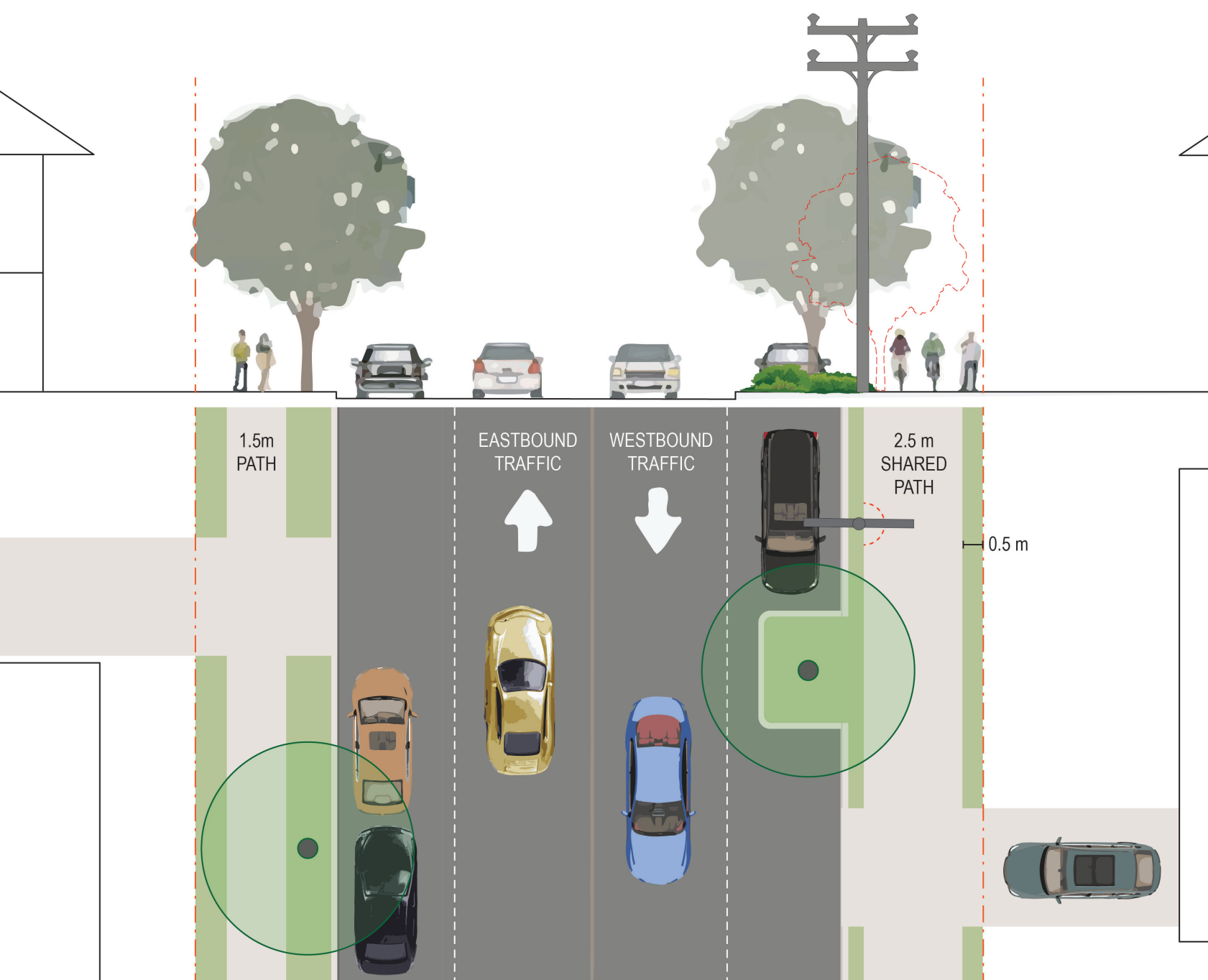
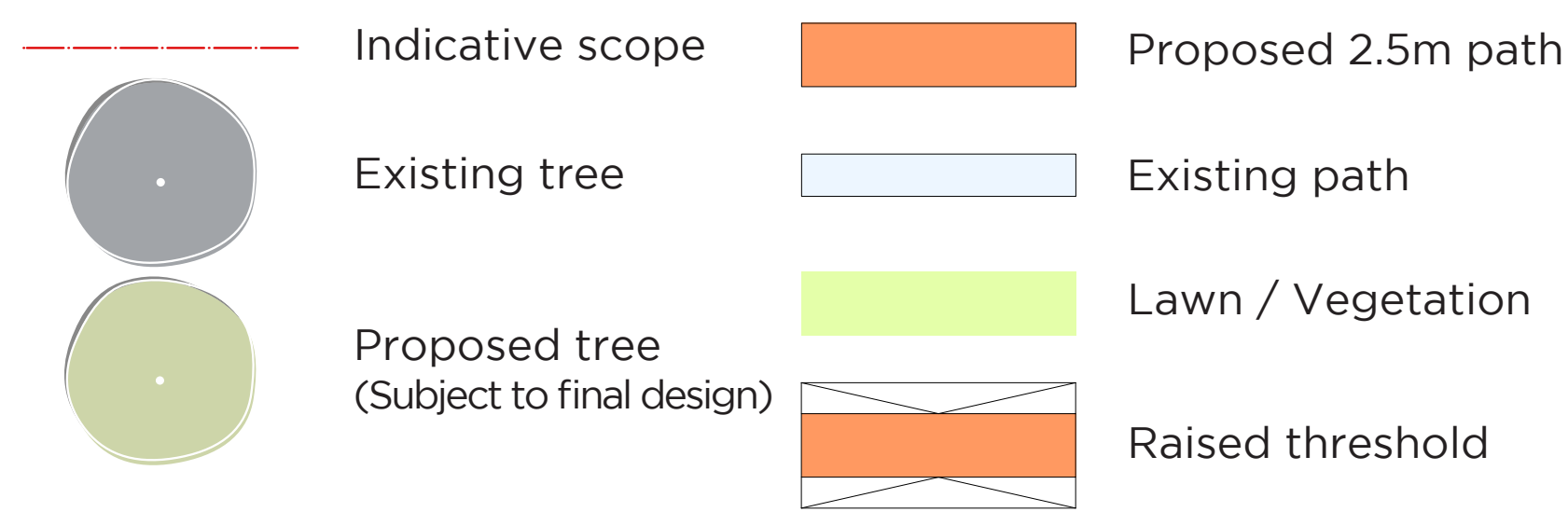


Diagram showing the typical street layout and upgraded footpath at Spring Street



Bayside Council is proposing to construct a new pedestrian and cycle shared path linking the Banksia and Arncliffe growth area to Barton and Riverine Park.

The proposed 1.3km long links starts at the Riverine Park entry, then along Spring Street and finishes at Banksia Station to the south and Arncliffe Town Centre to the north. It will provide pedestrians and cyclists with a safe off-road path between the Arncliffe and Banksia growth area and the recreational precinct at Barton and Riverine Park, encouraging residents to make use of the nearby public amenities.
